

Proverbs 20:1 Wine is a mocker, strong drink is a brawler, and whoever is led astray by it is not wise.

Proverbs 31:4-6 It is not for kings to drink wine, nor for princes intoxicating drink; lest they drink and forget the law, and pervert the justice of all the afflicted. Give strong drink to him who is perishing.

Ecclesiastes 2:3 I explored with my mind how to let my body enjoy life with wine and how to grasp follies.

Ecc 2:10 Whatever my eyes desired I did not keep from them. I did not withhold my heart from any pleasure

Habakkuk 2:5 Wine betrays the proud man, so that he does not stay at home.

Ecclesiastes 2:17 So I hated life, for the work which had been done under the sun was grievous to me; because everything is futility and striving after wind.

Luke 21:34-36 "Be on guard, so that your hearts will not be weighted down with dissipation and drunkenness and the worries of life. But keep on the alert at all times."

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober! Be on the alert! Your adversary the devil is prowling around like a roaring lion, looking for anyone he can devour.

Proverbs 23:19-20 Listen, my son, and be wise; keep your mind on the right course. Don't associate with those who drink too much wine.

Proverbs 23:29-35 Who has woe? Who has sorrow? Who has contentions? Who has complaints? Who has wounds without cause? Who has redness of eyes? Those who linger long at the wine, those who go in search of mixed wine. Do not look on the wine when it is red, when it sparkles in the cup, when it swirls around smoothly; at the last it bites like a serpent, and stings like a viper. Your eyes will see strange things, and your heart will utter perverse things. You'll be like someone sleeping out at sea or lying down on the top of a ship's mast. "They struck me, but I feel no pain! They beat me, but I didn't know it! When will I wake up? I'll look for another drink."

Proverbs 26:11 Like a dog that returns to its vomit Is a fool who repeats his folly.

Rom 14:21 It is a noble thing not to eat meat, or drink wine, or do anything that makes your brother stumble.

Habakkuk 2:15 Woe unto him that giveth his neighbour drink, that putteth thy bottle to him, and maketh him drunken also!

Matthew 18:6 "Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in Me to stumble, it would be better for him to have a heavy millstone hung around his neck, and to be drowned in the depth of the sea."

Leviticus 10:8-11 The LORD spoke to Aaron, saying: "Do not drink wine or intoxicating drink, you, nor your sons with you, when you go into the tabernacle of meeting, lest you die. It shall be a statute forever throughout your generations, that you may distinguish between holy and unholy, and between unclean and clean, and that you may teach the children."

Ephesians 5:18 And don't get drunk with wine, which leads to reckless actions, but be filled with the Spirit.
