HOPE

After spending 15 days in Southeast Asia with Rob Hurtgen, I saw the value of having hope.

We were in a country that is 80% Hindu. Amrutur V. Srinivasan helps us understand the Hindu religion. He says, "Hinduism is not an organized religion and has no single, systematic approach to teaching its value system. Nor do Hindus have a simple set of rules to follow like the Ten Commandments. Local, regional, caste, and community-driven practices influence the interpretation and practice of beliefs throughout the Hindu world."

They believe that truth is eternal, and that their god, Brahman is the one true god who is formless, limitless, all-inclusive and eternal and encompasses everything and everyone. The Hindu "scriptures" are "The Vedas" which are revelations by ancient saints and sages that are eternal. Everyone should strive to achieve dharma which is right conduct, righteousness, moral law and duty. Their souls are neither created nor destroyed and are involved in the cycle of reincarnation until they are liberated when they unite with Brahman by realizing its true nature.

Hindus live with images of their idols in their businesses, homes and visit temples to offer prayers and sacrifices to the thousands of gods to appease them. Their "hope" is to move up in the reincarnation process.

Their "hope" is in personal effort without set standards to measure their efforts. Real hope is in the finished work of Christ.
