*⁶And they went through the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been forbidden by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in Asia. ⁷And when they had come up to Mysia, they attempted to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus did not allow them. ⁸So, passing by Mysia, they went down to Troas. ⁹And a vision appeared to Paul in the night: a man of Macedonia was standing there, urging him and saying, “**Come over to Macedonia and help us.**” ¹⁰And when Paul had seen the vision, immediately we sought to go on into Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them. Acts 16:6-10 (ESV)*

Paul embarked on his second missionary journey to strengthen churches started on the first mission trip. Paul and Timothy attempted to east into the region of Bithynia, (Modern day Turkey), but God had other ideas. In a vision, God revealed that Paul should go west to Macedonia.

India has more unreached unengaged people groups than any nation in the world. The precious people of India are enslaved by the false gods of Hinduism and Muslim religions.

According to the IMB 7,051 unreached people groups exist in the world including 3,183 unengaged peoples. India contains 2,026 of these peoples, 29% of people without access to the gospel.

In November/December of 2017, Rob Hurtgen, pastor of FBC Chillicothe traveled to India to investigate the possibility of another mission opportunity. God directed us to a town named, “Malegaon,” pronounced “Mollygow.” This town has a population of 575,000 including 400,000 Muslims with one church.

I am asking you to pray about traveling to Malegaon, India to encourage and train a church to minister to their community. We will travel there October 27-November 3, 2018. The cost will be \$2,000, including airfare and living expenses for the trip. Pray for people Jesus died for who need to hear the good news of Jesus in India. Pray about your part in God’s mission.
