SCHOOL SECURITY

Visitors to the school will be required to stop in at the office and sign the visitor registration book.

At the end of the school day, students are dismissed from Mrs. Byrne’s classroom beginning at 2:45 p.m. Parents/individuals may wait in the school entrance until students have been dismissed into their care.

At the beginning of the school day doors will not be opened until 7:30 am. Teachers will not be in their classrooms until 7:45 am, therefore, any student arriving prior to 7:45 am will need to be seated on the bench outside of the school office. At the end of the school day doors will open at 2:30 pm.
