MAP TESTING

St. Paul has adapted a standardized test called **Map Growth** test to measure what students know and informs what they are ready to learn next. MAP Growth creates a personalized assessment experience that measures performance – whether a student performs on, above, or below grade level. The MAP test is administered to children 5k – 8th grade.

The MAP test will be taken several times throughout the year to measure the child’s growth. The MAP test is taken on a Chromebook and the results are immediate for a teacher. The results of the test are included in the family folder. You will notice that the results of last year’s test are included with this first test.

SCHOOL SECURITY

Visitors to the school will be required to stop in at the office and sign the visitor registration book.

At the end of the school day, students are dismissed from Mrs. Byrne's classroom beginning at 2:45 p.m. Parents/individuals may wait in the school entrance until students have been dismissed into their care.

At the beginning of the school day doors will not be opened until 7:30 am. Teachers will not be in their classrooms until 7:45 am, therefore, any student arriving prior to 7:45 am will need to be seated on the bench outside of the school office.

At the end of the school day doors will open at 2:30 pm.

PHYSICAL EXAMS
