SCHOOL SECURITY

Visitors to the school will be required to stop in at the office and sign the visitor registration book.

At the end of the school day, students are dismissed from Mrs. Byrne's classroom beginning at 2:45 p.m. Parents/individuals may wait in the school entrance until students have been dismissed into their care.

At the beginning of the school day doors will not be opened until 7:30 am. Teachers will not be in their classrooms until 7:45 am, therefore, any student arriving prior to 7:45 am will need to be seated on the bench outside of the school office.

At the end of the school day doors will open at 2:30 pm.

PICK UP CHANGE

In the event you need to change how your child will be picked up at the end of the day (bus to parent pick up or parent to bus pick up), please notify the office no later than 2:00 p.m.

PHYSICAL EXAMS

As printed in the Parent Handbook, all students participating in extracurricular activities must have a physical exam on file at the school office. A physical exam will be required for all students participating in extracurricular activities every two (2) years. An Alternate Year Card will need to be completed on the opposite year of the physical. This is for the health and safety of your child.
