From the Pastor...

Only 16 days and counting...at the time of the writing of this article at least... only 16 days and counting! Super Bowl Sunday! Humor me as I share with you some football terminology and how it easily transfers over into our church vocabulary.

Blocking...talking endlessly to the preacher at the church door and keeping everyone else from exiting.

Draft Choice...the decision to sit as close as possible to the window or fan in July and August.

Extra Point...what you get if you tell the preacher his sermon was too short.

Quarterback...what some folks want after putting fifty cents in the collection plate.

Illegal Motion...leaving before the benediction.

Two Minute Warning...when the chairperson of the Administrative Board starts pointing at their watch during the sermon.

There's one other word that I have saved for last...NFL. No, I am not talking about the National Football League...I am talking about the *Nudging, Forgiving and Leading* of God's grace.

Nudging Grace. Have you never felt God nudging you in your life? Wesley called that Prevenient Grace...the grace of God working in our lives before we are really even aware that it is working. It's not our doing...it's God's...where God just keeps loving us and lets that love nudge us closer and closer until we can see it, feel it and accept it for our own.

Forgiving Grace. Hey, this is what makes it all real. God just keeps nudging us toward a relationship...and in that relationship, God offers forgiveness. Wesley called this Justifying Grace...where we are forgiven and brought into a right relationship with God.

Leading Grace. So where does it all lead? Once you accept that forgiving grace, God leads us into a life that every day becomes more and more like the life of Christ. It's a hunger to be as loving and kind and caring and God-centered in our lives as Christ...to touch people with the Good News as He did. And guess what...the Good News is that we can!

Tom Landry once said... *The job of a football coach is to make men do what they don't want to do, in order to achieve what they have always wanted to be.* In a sense, that's what the NFL of God's grace is all about...God nudging us to do what we don't want to do in order to become what we've always wanted to be. God nudges us and loves us into a relationship. God forgives us and sets us free as a child of God. And God leads us into becoming more and more like Christ.

Carlson, currently the pastor of Eldridge-McCausland United Methodist Churches, has also served appointments as associate pastor at Lenox Clearfield-Mercer Center-Sharpsburg and associate pastor of St. John's United Methodist Church in Davenport

Bishop Laurie Haller has announced that Rev. Paul Wilcox will become the Superintendent of the Northeast District on July 1, 2018. Rev. Wilcox

succeeds Rev. Jackie Bradford who has served the district since 2011.

Ordained as Elder and elected into full membership in the Iowa Conference in 1984, Rev. Wilcox is pastor of Lovely Lane United Methodist Church in Cedar Rapids. His previous appointments include Springville, St. Luke's UMC in Newton, Harlan-Monroe Chapel and Trinity UMC in Charles City.

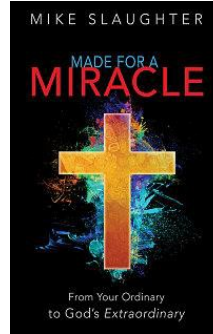

Groups will meet on Tuesday morning (10 am) & evenings (6:30 pm)...starting on February 20th.

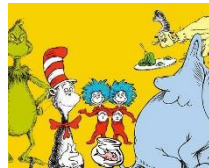

Reflections from the Church Historian...

(Part of this article was run in the previous issue of the "Messenger". That portion...and the remainder of the article... are being printed in their entirety. Next month's issue of the "Messenger" will include another article on our church history.

The cornerstone of the south half of our church complex was laid in 1893. That means next year, 2018, our sanctuary will have enveloped us with 125 years of Methodists worshipping together. Following is the first paragraph of an article about those beginnings.

The first Sunday in 1895 will be remembered as a memorable day in Methodism in Boone. On that day was dedicated the beautiful new First Methodist Episcopal church and over \$12,000 was subscribed by the liberal people of the congregation and of the city which wiped out every vestige of debt upon the church building, costing \$26,000 and provided money for all the little incidentals which may come up in settling up for the building of the beautiful new office...

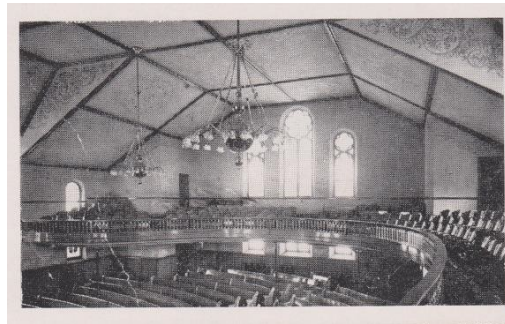


...Yesterday two immense audiences of 1,500 people each were present at the morning and evening dedicatory services with a big crowd, also, at the afternoon children's meeting... The sermon finished, Dr. Ives turned his attention to the debt of the church—\$12,000. He asked that half of it be made up in \$500 subscriptions and this was done in short order. Then \$200, \$100, \$50, \$15, \$10 and the lower subscriptions were called for by the genial divine who had a happy story or expression for every contingency which arose. The congregation responded nobly to his efforts and in little over an hour the \$12,000 was raised in good subscriptions...At the evening service Doctor Ives easily raised \$500 more to meet interest charges and incidentals...

Everybody present was delighted with the beauty of the new church...The new church is nearly square, being 79 x 80 feet in size. It is of Romanesque design and was planned by Architect E.C. Bell of Council Bluffs. The building is of pressed brick, trimmed with Colona sandstone and the corner towers and four fronts give to it a very handsome and picturesque appearance. There is a cluster of large windows on each of the four sides, giving the whole building a balance and artistic effect which is very pleasing. The main entrance to the church

is through the tower at the south east corner. This tower is the one from which the main spire ascends and in which the bell is located which will call the people to worship. Entrances almost as commodious are found at the northeast and southwest corners, while at the northwest corner is a smaller entrance by which the minister and choir can reach their places without going through the body of the auditorium.

The main auditorium of the church occupies the full sizes of the building. Entering it from either of the three entrances, one is immediately delighted with the comfort and beauty of the place. On all four sides the large windows of opalescent glass let in a light which is at once mellow and pleasant harmonizing splendidly with the prevailing colors of the church. The walls are frescoed in simple but elegant style, the ground work being of terracotta and from that up to the lighter shades. The carpets throughout are a rich mahogany color and this with the warm tints of the walls blend beautifully with the wood work of the room which is all of oak. The panels in the ceiling, which is 33 feet from the floor, are of solid oak, the organ is of oak, antique finish, the pulpit, altar, communion table, pews all of this beautiful wood, finished beautifully...



The arrangement of the main auditorium is unexcelled. The pulpit and rostrum are in the northwest corner. The floor of the auditorium slopes toward the pulpit. The seats are arranged in semi-circular form the aisles [covering] toward the pulpit and there is not a seat in the main floor or gallery which is not in plain view of the speaker...Immediately back of the pulpit is the extreme corner of the building is the great pipe organ. The organ is indeed a beauty...Instead of the ordinary bellows blowing wind into wooden pipes this organ has what is known as the universal wind chest which was patented by Mr. Austin only two years ago...The main body of the auditorium is fitted with easy pews of oak while the gallery, which extends across the south and east sides of the building...there are 250 chairs in the gallery, a seating capacity equal to that of the entire old church. The pews below will accommodate 650 people nicely...In the basement of the church are located the Sunday school rooms, lecture rooms, kitchen, etc. [In the kitchen, in] the cupboards are found a handsome set of glassware...and an elegant set of gold band china...In the basement is also located the heating apparatus of the church. The building is finely heated with a team plant...There is a 12-foot boiler with 54 3-inch flues, and there is 2,000 feet of radiation in the building.

February is...HEART MONTH

February is heart month so do yourself a favor and take care of it.

- Get your blood pressure checked and know your numbers. Guidelines are < 140/90 at rest. Uncontrolled high blood pressure can affect your left ventricle of your heart by enlarging it and making it weak. The amount of salt you take in also affects your blood pressure. It is not only the salt shaker but the hidden salt in foods. Daily sodium intake should be 2000-2300 mg per day.
- Get your lipid profile checked. Total cholesterol should be <200. Triglycerides (another type of fat) < 200. HDL (good cholesterol) for men should >45 and women >50. LDL or bad cholesterol should be around 100. Triglycerides are affected by sweets, alcohol and chocolate. You can get a wellness profile at Boone County Hospital and probably at Mary Greeley Hospital also without a doctor's order. You need to be fasting for 8 to 12 hours, go to patient registration, choose your profile you want and pay the fee. Then proceed to the lab and have your blood drawn. The lab will send you a copy and if you elect fax one to your doctor as well.
- Know your blood sugar level. Normal blood sugar is 80-100. Pre-diabetes 101-125 and diabetes 126 and above.
- Exercise is getting up and moving. Recommendation is 30 minutes of moderate intensity most days of the week or 150 minutes weekly. The type of exercise is what you like and will do for the rest of your life. Schedule it into your daily routine. Exercise will help with all the numbers above and with your stress!
- Metabolic syndrome is present if you have 3 or more of the 5 following: Triglyceride level >150 or drug therapy; Abdominal obesity Men waist circumference >40", women >35"; HDL < 40 men and < 50 women or drug therapy; Blood pressure > 130/85 or drug therapy; fasting blood sugar >100.

**So with your New Year's resolutions get off to a good start and start moving!
Your heart will thank you and so will you to keep doing those activities you want to do.**
