Thank you all for welcoming me so warmly as your new music director. I look forward to working with everyone on the following three goals. I would like:


- 1. To include everyone in music ministry who has any desire to participate,


we collected canned goods for the We Care ministry at our Birthday Party for Jesus. (We were so happy to collect 206 items for We Care!) It was a really busy month!
