**DAY #1 — A
POWER WASHER
WAS USED TO

DAY #2 - THE BUCKET IS LIFTED AGAIN OVER THE CHURCH ROOF TO THE COURTYARD AND THE WORKER ROLLED ON THE FIRST COAT OF PAINT.
