- Why is it that you do or do not believe in heaven or in some sort of life after death?

CONFIDENTIALITY CHECK: Is there anything that you shared here today that you would like held confidential? Otherwise, this is a reminder that we treat each other's sharing with kindness and respect.

We give thanks for one another, for the chance to share our lives, to renew our spirits. May we be enriched by our gathering, committed to living life fully and to supporting one another.
