- **3.** <u>II Timothy 4:2</u> "Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction."

Romans 1:15-16 "So, for my part, I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome. [15] For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek." [16]

<u>I Corinthians 2:1-5</u> "And when I came to you, brethren, I did not come with superiority of speech or of wisdom, proclaiming to you the testimony of God. [1] For I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified. [2] I was with you in weakness and in fear and in much trembling, [3] and my message and my preaching were not in persuasive words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, [4] so that

- your faith would not rest on the wisdom of men, but on the power of God." [5]
- **4.** <u>Hebrews 4:12</u> "For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart."

<u>I Corinthians 1:18</u> "For the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God."

<u>Psalm 119: 9</u> "How can a young man keep his way pure? By keeping it according to Your word

Psalm 19:7-11 "The law of the Lord is perfect, restoring the soul; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple. [7] The precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes. [8] The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the judgements of the Lord are true; they are righteous altogether. [9] They are more desirable than gold, yes, than much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and the drippings of the honeycomb. [10] Moreover, by them Your servant is warned; In keeping them there is great reward." [11]

5. I Corinthians 5:1-5 "It is actually reported that there is immorality among you, and immorality of such a kind as does not exist even among the Gentiles, that someone has his father's wife. [1] You have become arrogant and have not mourned instead, so that the one who had done this deed would be removed from your midst. [2] For I, on my part, though absent in body but present in spirit, have already judged him who has so committed this, as though I were present. [3] in the name of our Lord Jesus, when you are assembled, and I with you in spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus. [4] I have decided to deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of his flesh, so that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus." [5]

Matthew 18:15-20 "If your brother sins, go and show him his fault in private; if he listens to you, you have won your brother. [15] But if he does not listen to you, take one or two more with you, so that by the mouth of two or three witnesses every fact may be confirmed. [16] If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church and if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector. [17] Truly I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven. [18] Again I say to you, that if two of you agree on earth about anything that they may ask, it shall be done for them by My

Father who is in heaven. [19] For where two or three have gathered together in My name, I am there in their midst." [20]

- 6. Matthew 7:1-5 "Do not judge so that you will not be judged. [1] For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and by your standard of measure, it will be measured to you. [2] Why do you look at the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye? [3] Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' and behold, the log is in your own eye. [4] You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye." [5]
- 7. <u>Galatians 6:1</u> "Brethren, even if anyone is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; each one looking to yourself, so that you too will not be tempted."

<u>I John 5:16</u> "If anyone sees his brother committing a sin not leading to death, he shall ask and God will for him give life to those who commit sin not leading to death. There is a sin leading to death; I do not say that he should make request for this."
