2. **Matthew 18:15-17** “If your brother sins, go and show him his fault in private; if he listens to you, you have won your brother. [15] But if he does not listen to you, take one or two more with you, so that by the mouth of two or three witnesses every fact may be confirmed. [16] If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church and if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector.” [17]
3. **I Thessalonians 5:12**: “But we request of you, brethren, that you appreciate those who diligently labor among you, and have charge over you in the Lord and give you instruction.”

**I Timothy 5:17-18**: “The elders who rule well are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching.”

**I Peter 5:1-4**: “Therefore, I exhort the elders among you, as your fellow elder and witness of the sufferings of Christ, and a partaker also of the glory that is to be revealed, [1] shepherd the flock of God among you, exercising oversight not under compulsion, but voluntarily, according to the will of God; and not for sordid gain, but with eagerness; [2] nor yet as lording it over those allotted to your charge, but proving to be examples to the flock. [3] And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.” [4]

4. **Acts 6:1-6**: “Now at this time while the disciples were increasing in number, a complaint arose on the part of the Hellenistic Jews against the native Hebrews, because their widows were being overlooked in the daily serving of food. [1] So the twelve summoned the congregation of the disciples and said, ‘It is not desirable for us to neglect the word of God in order to serve tables. [2] Therefore, brethren, select from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may put in charge of this task. [3] But we will devote

ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word. [4] The statement found approval with the whole congregation; and they chose Sephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philp, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch. [5] And these they brought before the apostles; and after praying, they laid their hands on them. [6]

5. **Ephesians 2:19-22:** "So then you are no longer strangers and aliens but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household, [19] having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone, [20] in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord, [21] in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit. [22]
