



The conditions were quite poor. The prison now has 40-50 boys and 3 girls. In communications with us, she stated it has become a life-living part of her ministry and any act of love would make a huge difference. Once incarcerated, it is easy for them to get lost in the system.

The ladies of UMW-RR decided to hold a <u>BAKE SALE – "KAKES FOR KATIE'S KIDS</u>" to raise whatever funds we could to relieve some of their suffering and to give them a little joy and kindness. Blessings and Praise to the generosity of First Church – RR, for we were able to complete a <u>Super-Successful-Sale</u> on Sunday, November 17 and raised \$2,200 with more promises yet to be counted for this Mission.
