Gorethy started a sewing school for women, who otherwise would have no way of earning a living. Our Sisters of Sewing Circle connected with Congo Restoration and Gorethy, and they are providing sewing bags twice a year for the graduates of the sewing school.

In September of this year, Gorethy's newest dream was realized when the Girls' School of Compassion was opened in the Congo. With two classrooms for first and second grades, the school provides a chance for education for girls, who normally have no opportunity to attend a school.
