Dear Friends at St Clement's,

Happy New Year, again! As I write this we're frantically trying to get ready for Christmas Eve services as well as the First Sunday After Christmas – well, Irene is frantic, I'm just trying to stay out of the way! Sometimes it's hard to know how to be the most helpful, or when our attempts to be “helpful” are really just getting in the way. 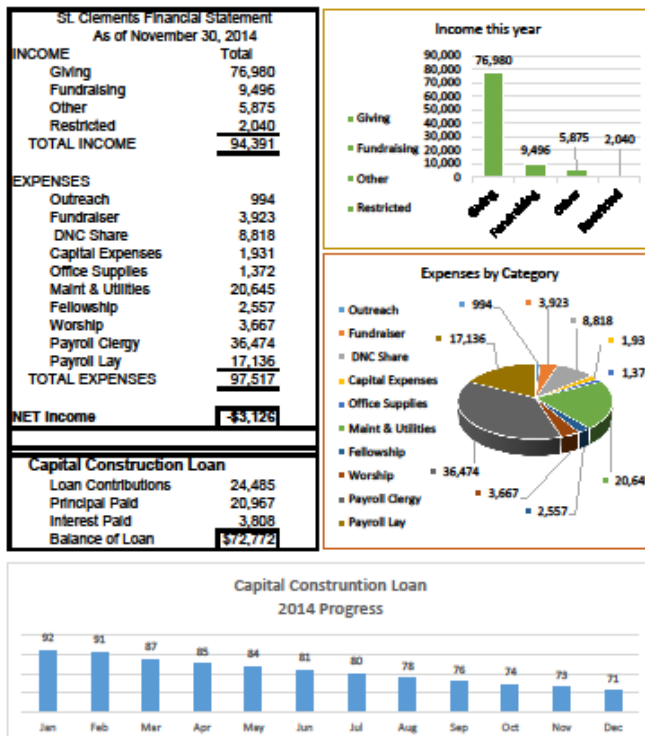
A Daughter pledges herself to a life-long program of prayer and service dedicated to the spread of Christ's Kingdom and the strengthening of the spiritual life of her parish.
