As I write this we are anticipating our historical experience of "Colonial Sunday" – on July 5th, when we will be using the Holy Communion service from the 1662 Book of Common Prayer – the book that would have been used in colonial Anglican Churches at the time of the Revolution in 1776. Those wishing are encouraged to get into the spirit by coming in period costume!

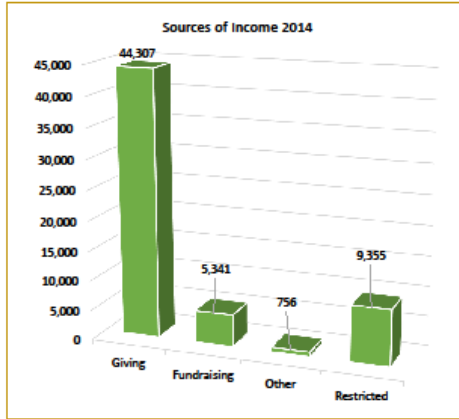
After that, we will "fast forward" to a very 21st Century style with a single service outside (you might call it "Mass on the grass"!) while our sanctuary undergoes renovation (electrical work, painting, new lighting, and visual aids that will eliminate the "binders" we've been using for years). How long this will take is uncertain, but what is certain is that, for the parts we are doing ourselves (such as painting) "many hands" would make for faster work! So, look for invitations in upcoming weekly editions of the "Anchor Lite" and please respond when the need is known and great!

In the meantime, we are exploring the possibility of a joint ministry venture with St Francis, Fair Oaks, who started a Senior Produce Market program last March. Some of our folks have gone over to observe and reported at our last Vestry meeting. The produce is fresh, healthy and very reasonably priced, and they would appreciate our support – either as helpers or shoppers! Check them out, Tuesdays, 10-11am. As we settle into our newly refurbished worship space, we will be looking for other ways to support our tradition of work in nutrition, including gearing up for this fall's CROP walk and our ongoing support for the River City Food Bank. And, next month, we'll shift to our expanding fellowship program, the "Anchor Group" and our newest opportunity for Sunday morning Adult Formation in response to the feedback we received from the survey conducted last April.

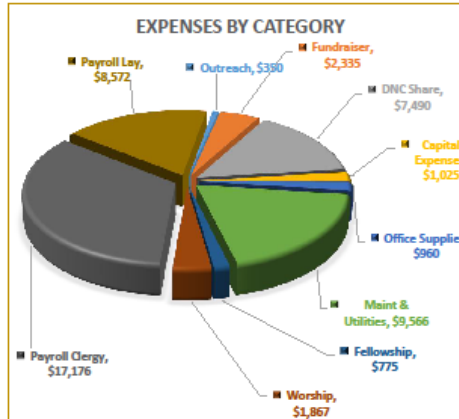
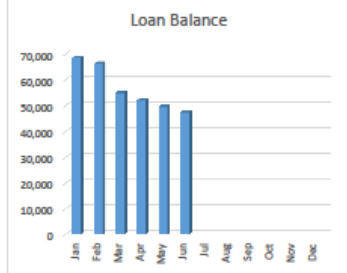
