Newly graced, he's going to do his southern culinary magic for another Tennessee BBQ the Saturday following his ordination (talk about a glutton for punishment!). And shortly thereafter, we will celebrate the Feast of Pentecost.


And interestingly, all of these are tied together with a common thread and theme – outreach to the wider world. All of us share a common ministry that started that first Pentecost day – to “show forth in our lives what we profess by our faith.” Our Feast is meant to remind us that all baptized Christians have been graced with that same Spirit that “danced on the heads of the Apostles like tongues of fire.” Part of our outreach is exercised by holding events that are open to our neighbors in our immediate community – events like the Tennessee BBQ this month, and a planned Fijian Luau in July, and our Founder's Day celebration later in September. We want them to know who we are, where we are, and that we welcome them to join us!

And finally, there is the special grace of being called to ordained ministry – in David's case, the priesthood. As a priest, he will be called to “nourish Christ's people from the riches of his grace, and strengthen them to glorify God in this life and in the life to come.” We gather as God's community in this community offering to nourish everyone who comes within our reach, offering them the riches of God's grace. To this ministry all of us are called.




## What Saint Clement's Does Best

What does the family of Saint Clement's do best? The parish was asked this question, and responses were given in-person and via e-mail. The goal is to identify what the parish feels it does best and to build on those gifts while developing future ministries.

Saint Clement's is a warm, welcoming, and loving household of faith. It is clear that the people of Saint Clement's warmly welcome visitors and present an open-hearted acceptance of all persons. The parish is made up of a diverse and widely talented family of believers, focused on the Christian faith and actively living into that faith. The P.I.E. Committee delivers a pie to the home of every visitor.

Coffee Hour socializing and discussions are relaxing times of fellowship and community. During this time the people of Saint Clement's share their stories and listen to the stories of others. This creates a bonding opportunity for both long-time parish members and visitors. The recently reactivated Anchor Group offers fellowship activities outside of the Church.

Saint Clement's is small enough to encourage personal relationships, yet is open to growth. The parish family is not afraid of growth or desirous of *staying the same*. New persons are readily welcomed into the family.

Outreach ministries include supporting the *CROP Walk*, *River City Food Bank*, *Veteran's Ministries*, *AA* and *NA groups*, and many others. Some have suggested we should expand on Veteran's ministries.

Music. The choir (*The Master's Singers*), the *Men of Saint Clements*, the *Ukupalians* and various special groups offer an exceptional array of praise and worship music. A great deal of time is spent developing these music ministries.

Worship is spiritually enriching thanks to the RCL and the Liturgical styles of our tradition. Our worship is Christ-centered and focused on the Lord's Table.

Every member of the Saint Clement's family is involved in some form of ministry or service in the Parish. The level of volunteerism is very high at Saint Clement's.

The Saint Clement's family is always ready and eager to reach out to persons in need or distress, not just within the Parish family, but in the larger community as well. We know that just filling the seats is not as important as filling the hearts and souls of real people.
