Dear Friends at St Clement's,

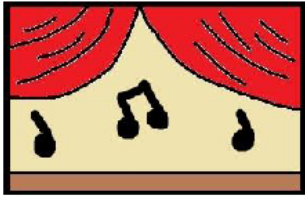
October is nearly half gone, and now we can all appreciate how much Harry Shippy does around St Clements! Sorry for getting this out to everyone so late.

Following Bishop Beisner's request we started with a talk by Bryan Stevenson about our criminal justice system, which led us to explore poverty, violence among the poor, the effects of income inequality, and related topics.

Starting on Sunday, 10/25, we will shift gears and begin our discussion of the book, "Jesus, Interrupted" by Bart Ehrman. While the title (and the last chapter - spoiler alert!) is somewhat provocative, it actually is a good introduction to the New Testament, how, by whom and when the various parts were written, and how it was put together over the first centuries of the church's existence. This will take us through till Advent, which begins the last Sunday in November.

In the meantime, as I write this, the CROP Walk is about to start, and I want to thank everyone from St Clements who is participating, either as a walker or a supporter! We have much to be thankful for, and this small congregation has a very large heart for helping those less fortunate. Bless you all!
