As we near the end of the school year, there are many announcements and much information, please read carefully.

Field Day—Friday, June 6 for Pre-K 4 through the 8th Grade.

The venue is Concordia College in Bronxville. Please return the permission slips that were sent home ASAP. A few reminders:

Students are to bring a **bagged lunch**. We will be outdoors so please send in multiple drinks. All lunches should be disposable. Don't forget the plastic spoons if needed

Students may wear **play clothes** to Field Day. Please have them wear **sneakers** instead of sandals or flip flops. They will be participating in organized games.

Dismissal is at 1:30 PM. The children will leave Concordia at 1:00 PM.

They will report first to their classrooms so all children are accounted for before being dismissed. Even if the parents are coming to the Field Day, all students must be transported by bus.

Siblings are not invited to Field Day due to insurance regulations.

Sunblock and insect repellent must be applied at home. Do not send it into school with your child for the teacher to apply.

There is Aftercare after the children return to school.

Students are expected in school at the regular time.

8th Grade Graduation is June 16th at 7:30 PM. All are welcome to attend.

There is a reception in the gym following the service. Thank you to our Chime Choir who will be playing at the graduation.
