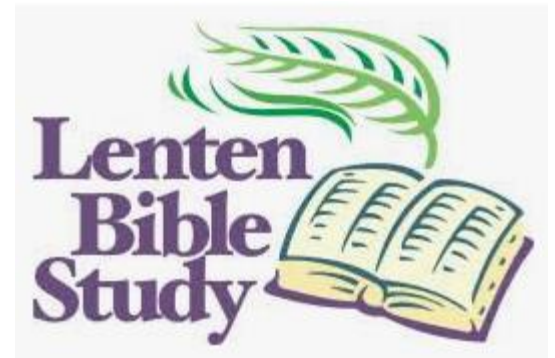


Lenten Bible Study
