

Volunteers assisting COVID vaccination clinics

Thank you for being willing to help the community as we provide COVID vaccinations to as many people as possible. SCDHEC is conducting multiple clinics and Public Health Reserve Corps volunteers are assisting in this effort.

In order to prepare volunteers to assist with COVID vaccination clinics, we have several options depending on your interests, background and availability. The chart below will help you decide what level of volunteer you would like to be, and whether or not you would like to assist only at your Church or at other community locations:
