Website Privacy Policy

Respecting user privacy over the Internet is of utmost importance to us. This privacy policy describes the current policies and practices with regard to personal data collected and/or displayed by Trinity Presbyterian Church of Surfside Beach, Inc. (collectively "we," "us," "our" and herein after referred to as "Trinity") through our Website. The term "personal data" refers to personally identifiable information, such as but not limited to your name, birth date, wedding anniversary date, email address, mailing address, and personal photograph that may appear in the password protected Member Area. "Personal data" also includes the use of photographs of church events that may include pictures of church members, visitors, volunteers and community members.

In general, you can visit our website without telling us who you are or providing any information about yourself. In some areas of the Website, programs such as the Member Area, have been designed to perform specific functions for you directly through our Website. Within these programs we may ask you to provide information that will enable us to offer services to you. In some instances the information may include personal data.

This privacy policy applies to information submitted by you and/or collected online by us.

Your consent

By using this website, you consent to our use of your personal data as described in this privacy policy. Your specific consent is requested in the Member Area upon submission of any personal data.

Notification of changes to this policy

We are continually improving and adding new functionality and features to this website. Because of these ongoing changes, changes in the law, and the changing nature of technology, we may revise this privacy policy from time to time. If and when the policy changes, we will post a dated notice on our home page informing you that a change has been made.

Use of personal data collected through this website

Information, including but not limited to personal data, that we collect will not be sold, rented, lent, exchanged or used by an individual or entity other than Trinity and the governing body of Trinity unless otherwise indicated. This includes, for example, the information you provide when you register for the Member Area, or when you send us your comments or requests for information.

We use the information you provide for the purposes for which it was originally collected, for example, to respond to your email or to provide the Member Area services you requested. We

may also use this information to help us improve the content and functionality of our website, to better understand the needs and interests of the people and organizations that use our website, and to improve our programs and services. This information may be used to contact you in the future to tell you about events within Trinity and its' programs and services.

Unless we have your permission or are otherwise required by law to release, the personal data provided by you online will not be shared with other PC(USA) entities and governing bodies to enable them to contact you regarding services, benefits, or mission opportunities or with other third parties who act on our behalf to administer our website unless it is to protect the security or integrity of our databases on this website; and with our successors in interest through corporate merger, reorganization, dissolution or similar event. In the event of a release to any third party described above, your personal data will not be released until the PC(USA) entity, governing body, or third party has agreed in writing to be bound by the terms of this Privacy Policy.

Any destruction of personal data will be done in a manner consistent with the intent of this policy.

Anonymous data collected through this website

In addition to the information you provide when you use this website, we use technology to collect anonymous information about the use of the website. For example, we use technology to track how many visitors access the website and which pages they view.

This technology does not identify you personally. It simply enables us to compile statistics about our visitors and their use of our website. We use this anonymous data and may share it with third parties for various reasons; for example, to improve the content and functionality of the website, to better understand the needs and interests of our visitors, to improve our programs and services.

Children

We do not knowingly collect personal data from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under thirteen, please do not give us any personal data in our Member Area. If you have reason to believe that a child has provided personal data on this Website, please contact us at the church office and we will endeavor to delete that information. If you are a child under the age of thirteen and using this website, please do not give any information about yourself, such as your name, address, birth date, phone number, school or email address. If we develop any online programs for children in the future, we will adopt appropriate policies and practices to protect the privacy of children.
