ADVENT CANDLE LITURGY

But how often do we let our preparations— or our memories— push joy to the side? Joy is like an underground spring that wells up within us, but joy is also a choice, an attitude. Teach us the peace that comes from justice. Fill us with the kind of joy that cannot be contained, but must be shared. Prepare our hearts to be transformed by you, That we may walk in the light of Christ. Amen.
