Arrival (at campsite):

Friday, May 3rd from 6:00-7:00pm

Departure (from campsite):

Monday, May 6th by 11:30am

*ALL PARTICIPANTS must stay for the entire event unless previous arrangements for late arrival or early departure have been with Camp Director.
(This is campground requirement.)*

Location:

H.E. Butt Foundation Camp
12 miles North of Leakey, TX off Hwy. 83

Once inside the campgrounds, *Linnets Wings* is our campsite (see <https://www.foundationcamp.org/linnets-wings/> for a description & pics).

PLEASE NOTE: *There is NO internet or cell phone reception in the Canyon, so cell phones WILL NOT work.*



Plan to be unplugged for the weekend. It'll be good for you!

RESTRICTIONS: *Pets, alcohol, weapons & fireworks are strictly prohibited by the campground. Smoking IS NOT allowed inside any of the buildings, and any cigarette butts that come in with you, MUST go out with you.*

WHAT TO BRING:

Please limit yourself to two bags (including bedding).

- A smile
- A spirit of cooperation
- A heart open to the Holy Spirit
- Bible
- Flashlight
- Towel, wash cloth & shower shoes
- Toothbrush, toothpaste
- Soap & other toilet articles/personal items
- Sunscreen & insect repellent
- Pillow & blanket/sleeping bag (or sheets for twin-sized bunk bed)
- Blue jeans (for hiking & night activity)
- Camp clothing (shorts, t-shirts, underwear, etc.)
(Please do not bring your best clothes, spaghetti-strap or low-cut shirts, short-shorts, very tight-fitting items)
- Pajamas
- Socks
- Tennis shoes or other sturdy shoes
- Sweater or light jacket (it can get chilly at night!)
- Travel alarm/watch
- Plastic bag (for wet clothing/towels)

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

- Camera
- Your favorite board game
- Box fan ☺
- Hanger for roasting marshmallows (*NOT vinyl-coated*)
- Swimsuit (*NO bikinis or midriff baring suits unless worn under a t-shirt*)
- Beach towel
- Swimming shoes (*all swimming is in the river*)
- Life jacket (*for swimming or water activities*)
- Fishing rod, bait, etc.
All participants under 64 years of age must have a fishing license. All fishing is on a catch-and-release basis. Bait is not available at camp, so please plan to bring your own fishing gear & bait.

WHAT NOT TO BRING (in addition to restricted items mentioned above):

- A chip on your shoulder
- A closed mind
- SANDALS OR FLIP-FLOPS - *trust us on this!*
- Fancy clothes or jewelry
- Anything easily lost or broken
- Food (*all meals/snacks will be provided - please do not bring additional food/drinks unless you have special dietary needs that the camp staff has been made aware of.*)

PLEASE NOTE: *This is a semi-rustic campground with no air-conditioning and limited access to electrical outlets. It may not be possible for participants to use blow-dryers or electric curlers/curling irons, etc. Please plan appropriately.*

IMPORTANT NOTE: *This campsite is somewhat handicap accessible. There will still be lots of walking required to get from cabins to dining hall, etc., but it's fairly level ground...except when you head down by the river. There is also parking available near all the cabins, so you won't have to haul your stuff too far! There are handrails and wide steps going down to the river from the dining hall, but no ramps, etc. (See pics below for a general idea of the layout.)*



Camp Duty:

All participants will be assigned some type of camp duty during the weekend.

All participants will assist with cleaning the campsite prior to departure on Monday morning.

Camp Rules:

1. Thou shalt observe ALL camp rules, both written & spoken.
2. Thou shalt use a buddy system AT ALL TIMES.
3. Thou shalt be on time for all scheduled events.
4. Thy body shall not leave the group area at any time without letting camp staff know where you'll be.
5. Thou shalt NOT trespass on thy neighbor's body or self-esteem.
6. Thou shalt report any accident, injury or illness to camp staff IMMEDIATELY (*if not sooner!*).
7. Thou shalt NOT enter the water for ANY reason without the camp lifeguard present.
8. Thou shalt NOT remove anything (*including rocks, wood or plants*) from camp property, except what you brought with you.
9. Thou shalt ALWAYS use trash receptacles - littering is NEVER permitted.
10. Thou shalt have a good and safe time!
