Recently I viewed a website by an organization that claimed to be Christian and that it was founded on the teachings of Christ. As you read the "ABOUT US" page and their creed statement you quickly find out that it supports the LGBTQ agenda, abortion, climate and social justice. It is obvious that they do not follow all the values of God's Word for here is one of their creed statements:

"We stick up for courageous Christian voices acting for fairness and freedom in every denomination, and we work together for immigrant and refugee rights, climate justice, and full LGBTQ inclusion, among other important social, economic, and racial justice causes that reflect the values Jesus taught."

"But there were also false prophets among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you. 2 Peter 2:1-2

This has been a favorite song of mine from the band PETRA since it was released in 1990. A creed is a confession, proclamation, or statement of faith. As I alluded to in my last article there are many organizations, denominations, pastors, and independent churches that claim to be Christian but do not hold on the true words of Jesus Christ and the Bible. They are culling from God's Word and are either deleting or ignoring what they think is not applicable in today's society. All of the Bible is applicable in today's society. Jesus said in Matthew 15:8, "These people honor me with their lips, but their heart is far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men." Jesus and His disciples warned us that these deceivers were out there and with more still to come.
