Our Mission, Our Ministry

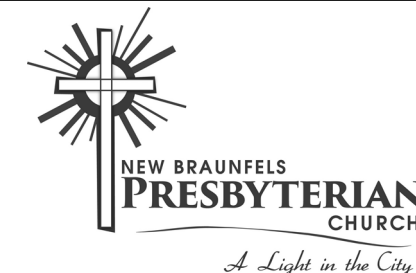
