Guidelines for Grants to Small Churches Outreach Program

The grant program is intended to be “Grants for Small Churches” and, of course, Pastors are part of the mix. Our definition of a “Small Church” is one with average weekly attendance of 100 or less. Grants may be awarded for a variety of reasons including educational or youth programs, outreach projects, facilities improvement, music, pastor study grants, Christian materials or other needs.

There is no application form, per se, but a general outline of information we would like to review (on Church letterhead stationery and signed by the Pastor or the leader of your Mission and Outreach Committee) is as follows:

1. The purpose of the grant and how it will be used to further the ministry or mission of your church.
2. Basic information about the church, size of your congregation, average worship attendance, pastoral leadership and Sunday school attendance.
3. The amount requested and when the grant is needed.
4. Contact name and information for the church including email address and phone number. The request should include the street address of the church as we are foreclosed from issuing grant money to post offices boxes.
5. An agreement to provide feedback to let us know whether objectives for use of the grant were accomplished.

The guidelines are not intended to be handcuffs thus allowing some room for discretion in the review process.
