NEW AUTO THEFT TECHNIQUE

Thieves have a new way to steal your car. They have acquired a jamming device that prevents your remote from locking your car if you push the button on your remote while walking away from your vehicle. If you use the remote to lock your vehicle make sure you see the lights blink or horn sound, whichever signals that the vehicle is actually locked.

DID YOU KNOW?

- 40-50% of vehicle theft is due to driver error.
- The top two months for vehicle thefts are July and August.
- Only about 52% of stolen vehicles are recovered.

USE COMMON SENSE WHEN PARKING AND EXITING YOUR VEHICLE.

- Take your key; don't leave it in or on your vehicle.
- Close and lock all windows and doors when you park.
- Park in well-lit areas in a garage, if possible.
- Never leave valuables in your vehicle, and specially in sight.
