Back to School Program

From a letter to the church,
dated September 16, 2013

Although this was another difficult year economically, we were amazed at the outpouring of help for the students in need of help in our county. Through the efforts of 949 donors, we were able to assist more than 6,700 students in 75 county elementary schools with backpacks and school supplies. More than \$35,000 was received in cash donations, which enabled us to help those students who were not picked up by a donor and assist 12 county middle schools with \$1,000 each to purchase school supplies for their students.
