Dr. Kevin Smith, our BCMD Executive Director will be the speaker.

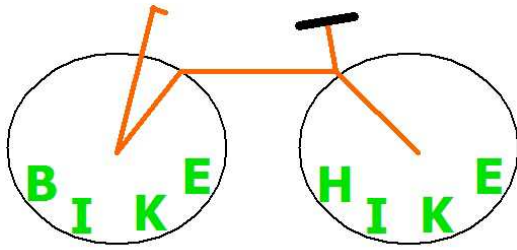
