Our Deacon Benevolence Fund helps dozens of families per year with rent, utilities, medicine, gas money for travelers stranded here.

About 20% of our budget goes to various missions causes - missionary support, missions work in Maryland & Delaware, Deaf camps, starting new churches, local food pantry and clothes closet.

We have baptized 95 people at EBC, while 262 different persons have been members here. Many of these, God has moved on to other places. A few have preceded us into death. There have also been dozens more who were a part of us but did not become members. There were many children who came to Vacation Bible School every year, and Sunday School occasionally.

We can praise God for all He has done in and through us as Emmanuel Baptist Church of Gambrills.
