Our focus in verses 16-18

The question is, does this last part of verse 18 refer only to giving thanks, or also to the commands to rejoice and pray?

My personal opinion is that all three of these commands are part of "God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

- All three are based on God's promises.
- All three are part of a proper faith \_\_\_\_\_ to these promises.

**1. Make \_\_\_\_\_ your faith response to God's promises.**

Ecclesiastes 3:1-2
