The **Mission Committee** of Harmony Church would like your help with gathering items for the **New Castle City Rescue Mission** and the **Hope Place**.

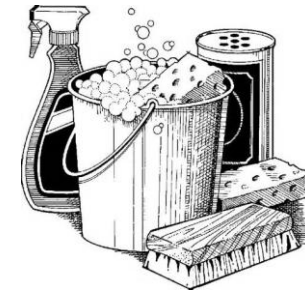
The following items are needed for the Rescue Mission to distribute to local families:
