Bible Study: Sunday nights at 6:00 pm. Come and hear Ligon Duncan speaking on worship as a way to fight biblical anemia.

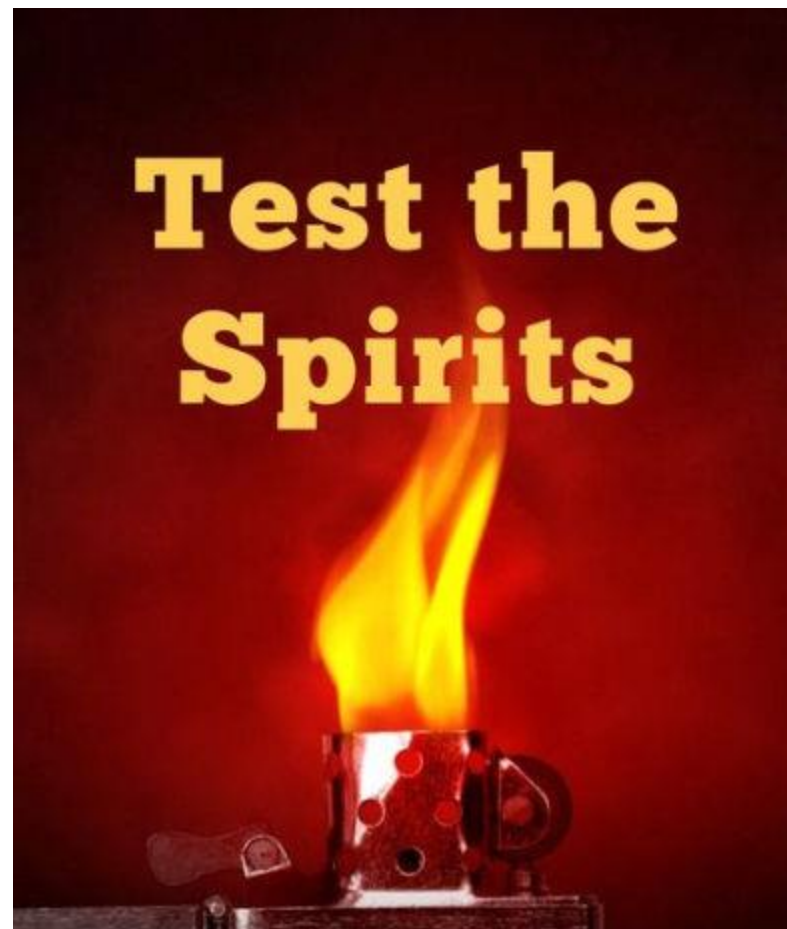
