I know I have already put this information out there in mailings and emails,

but I want to make sure folks are as informed as possible when it comes to our Advent and Christmas season.

We will not be having in-person Mid-week Advent services this year. A service of Holden Evening Prayer will be available on-line both on Peace's YouTube and Facebook pages. These will be available on Wednesday evenings at 7pm on December 2nd, 9th, and 16th. They will remain posted so you can watch them any time after that as well. There will also be an online "Longest Night" service that will be available starting at 7pm on December 21st. This is a collaborative service put on by the pastors of the churches in our Ashland/Richland conference. I will send out links to all of these services like I do for Sunday morning.

For Christmas Eve this year, there will be three opportunities to worship. There will be an online service available beginning at 5pm on Christmas Eve. There will also be a 5pm in-person service in the sanctuary. This service will be RSVP only since we will need to limit the number of people attending in order to keep the service as safe as possible. Please contact me by email or phone if you wish to attend the indoor service. Those in attendance will be required to wear masks. We will social distance and there will be no congregational singing. I will lead a few Christmas hymns and we will celebrate Communion. Then there will be a 7:30pm service that will be held outside in the back parking lot. Assuming technology co-operates, folks will have the option to park in the back parking lot listening to the service in their cars via their car radio or to park in the side lot and gather outside together where we will have the portable sound system set up. Those who are standing outside will need to wear masks and we will stay socially distant from one another. Having this service outside will, however, allow us to sing together for Christmas Eve and we will celebrate Communion. You will not need to RSVP for this service. If you have any questions about how attending these services will work, please reach out to me.

I will continue to pray for good weather for Christmas Eve, but we are Midwesterners. We're used to cold. I know this year's worship will not look like normal, but it is my hope to have a meaningful worship service available to anyone in the way that they feel most comfortable participating.

Remember our Shut Ins on your Christmas Card Mailings!


We give thanks for our Christian community as we gather together for worship each week. There are faithful people in our congregation, however, whose health no longer allows them to join us on Sunday mornings.
