"Then Peter came and said to him, "Lord, if another member of the church sins against me, how often should I forgive? As many as seven times?" Jesus said to him, "Not seven times, but, I tell you, seventy times seven times."—Matthew 18:21-22

Theo has always been fond of music. Currently, his favorite song is a little ditty called, "Hand Clap" by Fitz and the Tantrums. What this means is I currently listen to this song roughly 10-20 times a day. Theo can't yet say, "hand clap," but he has learned the word "again," which is a very useful little word for a toddler. Not so fun for mom and dad, but I digress. He will, many times throughout the day, walk over to our Amazon Echo, point, and then say "again" whilst clapping his hands. He makes his desires known. And so we listen to "Hand Clap" again... and again... and again... and again... and again... and again... and nauseam. His enthusiasm for the song is relentless.

A child's affinity for repetition is something unparalleled in adulthood. I'm tired of the song. I would expect anyone else to be. Theo isn't. Repetition isn't annoying for him. It's not tiring. It's how he learns. It's familiar. There's a lesson for us there.

When asked about how many times a person is to forgive, Jesus says, "not seven times, but seventy times seven times." And the point Jesus is making here isn't a test of our math skills. He's saying we are to forgive repeatedly- relentlessly. Forgive again... and again... and again... and again... and our call to forgive relentlessly comes out of our Christian call to love one another as Christ first loved us. We are called to love again... and again... and again... and again... relentlessly. Both this relentless love and this relentless forgiving are difficult for us. We easily grow tired of it and find it an annoyance. Why should we love and forgive those who don't seem deserving? But regardless of our evaluation of who is and is not deserving of our love and forgiveness, Jesus' answer doesn't change. Love relentlessly. Forgive relentlessly.

So here, perhaps, we can learn a lesson from the smallest among us. Repetition is not tiring; it's not annoying. It's the stuff of learning. And through our learning it can become familiar, something we do without even having to think about it. So let's take a cue from our children-love relentlessly, forgive relentlessly, in the name of Christ.
