

Training of Trainers on March 16


As part of our **5th annual Learning Day for Laity & Clergy**, Carol Barnes, Safe Sanctuaries coordinator for the Upper New York



Bishop Mark J. Webb will host an **all-clergy gathering** on **Saturday, March 9**, from **10 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.** at Asbury First UMC in Rochester.

Session, and remember our individual and collective call to ministry and mission in the name of Jesus Christ," Bishop Webb said.
