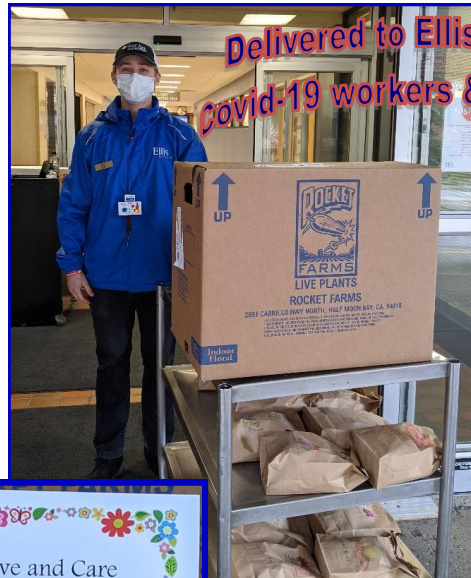

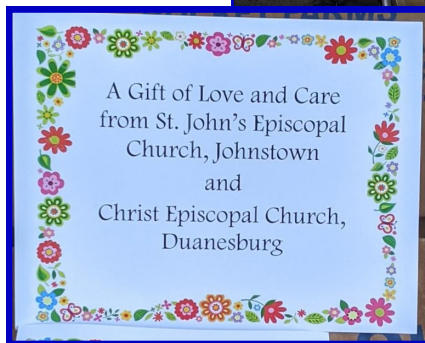


# Congratulations to the Class of 2020!
