## November 2021 "We walk by faith, not by sight," 2 Corinthians 5:7

Alistair's phone tells him the weather by the minute: "Snow in five minutes", or "Rain for the next 120 minutes". I am very attracted to whatever app tells him this because it is so exact in its predictions. Wouldn't it be great if we had those kinds of warnings in our own lives?

"Sadness for the next two weeks" or "Great joy within the next hour!"

We would be able to prepare for things that were about to happen. St. John's would really benefit from that as well: "Boiler will be breaking down over the weekend" or "Large donation coming to the church within the next year!"

But that doesn't happen. We walk forward in faith every minute of every day. That doesn't mean we are blind, but that we are to see our lives, our world, our possessions, and our families with God's eyes. That means we see our church with faith, and the ministry we take on with eyes of faith.
