JANUARY

- ◇ This is going to be a very busy year and January is just the beginning! Last week we broke ground on what will be the Mission House Garden (a ministry which falls under OTG Mission). The garden is all of 25 feet by 75 feet! Planting will begin the first part of February. Its purposed will be to provide additional food stores for the ministry as we endeavor to feed those who come here, some will go into a produce stand (which will open sometime in March or April) to be sold to provide additional funds to this ministry and the remainder will go to our local food bank to help those in our community.
- ◇ At the end of the month we are receiving a new batch of chicks which will be providing eggs by late April. This to will help the ministry as well as be sold in the produce stand.
- ◇ Bible Study for the homeless of Tyler will continue three days a week. If you would like to attend or have interest in helping the homeless feel free to ask us.
- ◇ January 22nd we are starting a new Bible study in Whitehouse on Thursday nights at 19369 CR 2171 called Mission House New Testament Bible Study from 7pm to 8pm.

FEBRUARY

- ◇ February is the beginning of the spring planting season so greens, potatoes and onions will be our first course of business!
- ◇ Bible Study for the homeless of Tyler will continue three days a week. If you would like to attend or have interest in helping the homeless feel free to ask us.
- ◇ Mission House New Testament Bible Study will continue from 7pm to 8pm.
- ◇ We are always available incase there is need so don't hesitate to ask. If you just need to talk, that's okay too.
- ◇ If you would like to be a volunteer for On The GO Mission we would love to hear from you. You can find an application on the website that gives more information that will allow you to do as much as little as you have time for. We would love to start a "card" ministry and a "visitation" ministry for shut-ins to have a visit or phone call once a week. We also need someone who can help with social media and fundraising. These are a few of the volunteer needs that we have. If you or someone you know might feel a calling to fill any position, please do not hesitate to let us know.
- ◇ We would like to make 60 to 75 Valentine Cards and treat bags for the needy families in Whitehouse. We will be distributing these through the Philadelphia Blessing House (our local food pantry) and will need to have them there by Monday morning Feb. 9th.

MARCH

- ◇ Mission House New Testament Bible Study will continue from 7pm to 8pm.
- ◇ The first of the Mission House Garden will have been planted and we will be preparing for the next phase of planting i.e. peppers, cucumbers, tomatoes, melons etc.
- ◇ March 8th is daylight savings time and we will Spring ahead one hour (bummer)
