- 1. Members of the NTC UMW Leadership Team will seek to identify opportunities and engage with potential UMW member groups at NTC UMC churches with lapsed and/or no organized local unit of UMW, including non-English-speaking UMC churches.
- Continue to improve NTC UMW communication with all individual NTC UMW members, local UMW units, NTC UMW District Mission Teams, NTC UMC Communications team and NTC UMC churches.
- 3. Build on the established partnerships with UMW National Mission Institutions -- Wesley-Rankin Community Center and Dallas Bethlehem Center for the following purposes: (1) increase the missions' awareness of the purpose of UMW and potential of members volunteering; and (2) encourage local unit UMWs' awareness and understanding of these two local missions and their members' involvement with them.
- 4. Encourage local UMW units of NTC UMW to track and report mission projects to their respective district mission teams.
- 5. Promote giving to the National UMW Legacy Fund.
- 6. Promote the importance of local UMW units achieving "Recognized Unit" status: minimum of 80 % of local UMW units will achieve annual "Recognized Unit" status by completing specified activities listed on the NTC UMW Local Unit Checklist.
- 7. Encourage all members of the NTC UMW Leadership Team attend and/or participate in at least 4 of 5 of the following NTC UMW events: UMW Texas Legislative Event, Racial Justice/Spiritual Growth Event, Mission u, UMW Reading Program, and the NTC UMW Annual Meeting.
- 8. Appoint a Database Manager to update and maintain a current digital database (minimum of 4,500 names) of all NTC UMW local unit members for the purpose of improving communication.
