It's so-o CONFUSING!

Last month the BGCO announced that changes are coming to the Baptist Messenger. We all love the Baptist Messenger. It provides information and inspiration for Oklahoma Baptists. But the announcement and coming changes have caused some confusion.

One source of confusion is that most people receive the Capital Baptist Association newsletter with their copy of the Baptist Messenger. The CBA newsletter is on the inside of the Baptist Messenger "wrap" (that white paper wrapper that comes on the outside of your Baptist Messenger). One of the changes that the BGCO and Baptist Messenger are making is that they will no longer print the "wrap." That means that you will no longer receive the CBA newsletter with your copy of the Baptist Messenger.

We want you to continue to receive the CBA Newsletter! Our newsletter contains news and articles about the churches in our local network. The CBA newsletter informs church members about training opportunities, mission trips, and ministry resources. And several times a year we publish the record of contributions from member churches which provides fiscal accountability, both for the association and individual churches. CBA uses other means of communication, like our website and FaceBook pages, but if you don't receive the CBA newsletter we all lose a critical point of communication.

Our plan is to publish a CBA newsletter once a month. We will be happy to mail it to you or send an electronic copy to you by email. But we need to know how to get it to you. We will be asking CBA churches to give us the addresses or email addresses of members who want to receive the newsletter, but it would help if you would call or email our office to subscribe (at no cost) to the CBA Newsletter. You may call 942-0244 or email julie@cbaokc.net.

Now, what about your subscription to the Baptist Messenger? The Baptist Messenger will be published twice a month instead of every week. They will work with churches to make sure that no one loses their subscription. If you have questions about continuing to receive your copy you may check with your church office or call the BGCO at 942-3800 and ask for the Baptist Messenger Office.
