

## Worship Rally Dig Site

*For the hole: use binder clips to clip several shallow boxes together. Cover the boxes with brown paper and insert a bamboo skewer into each intersection. Use orange cord to connect the skewers, creating a grid. Tie flagging tape to plungers to cordon off the hole.*



## Wall

- Boxes
- Brown paint
- Brush



*Lay the boxes flat. Paint a brown border around all 6 sides. Go back in with the paint and round the corners and add a few highlights. Offset the boxes when you stack them.*

## Small Jug

- Bottle with handle
- Small cup
- Masking tape
- Raffia
- Crayon



*Tape the cup to the top of the bottle. Cover the whole bottle and cup with little, torn pieces of masking tape. Rub the crayon over the tape. Wrap the handle with a length of raffia. Add a few rings of raffia around the neck of the bottle.*

## Large Pottery

- Ball
- 3 buckets
- Tape
- Tissue paper
- Mod Podge®
- Paint
- Raffia



*Tape the bottom of the ball in one bucket, then tape another bucket up-side down over the top of the ball. Tape the third bucket to the bottom of the inserted bucket.*

*Cover the entire sculpture with tape. Decoupage tissue paper over the entire pot. You may want to tint the decoupage medium with a little paint. Add raffia around the neck of the pottery.*

## Pop-Up Canopy

*Put the pop-up canopy over a table for Mess Tent Snacks. The canopy would also be good to use over the Dig Site for Worship Rally, or for the tent in Bible Study.*



## Bible Study Tent:

- Tension rod
- Plastic table cover

*Use a tension rod to hang a rectangular plastic tablecloth in the door of the Bible Study room. Cut a slit in the front panel and pull back to either side creating a door. Hang a round plastic table cover from the ceiling in the center of the room.*



*OPTION: Hang a game parachute in the room to create the tent.*

## Missions Market

- Place a TV and DVD player on one side of the focal wall.
- Use fishing line to hang a rod about a foot above the TV. Hang a second rod just above the top of the TV about a foot in front of the first rod.
- Drape a length of fabric over the rods to create an awning



## Crate

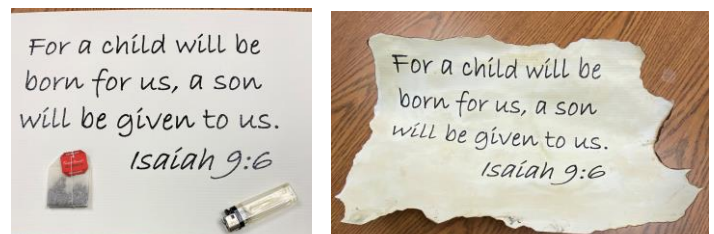
- Cardboard box
- Masking tape
- Craft knife
- Brown crayon

*Tape a length of masking tape around the top of a cardboard box. Use another piece of tape to go around the bottom. Also apply tape to each corner. Use a craft knife to cut out the box between the pieces of tape. Use a crayon to draw woodgrain on the tape. Fill the crate with paper shred and artificial fruits and vegetables.*



## Parchment

- Large, tan paper
- Printer
- Tea bag
- Candle and lighter
- Ventilated area



*Print the verse on the paper. Use a tea bag to stain the paper. While the scroll is wet, tear the edges. Use a lighted candle to scorch the edges. This is best done over the kitchen sink with the kitchen vent open.*

**Artifact Crafts Sign:** Print "Artifact Crafts" on a large piece of cream-colored paper. Blot a tea bag randomly over the paper to stain. Use Mod Podge® to glue the paper to foam insulation. When everything is dry, use a craft knife to trim some of the insulation away to create the look of broken pottery.



### Display Markers:

Print the title on plain paper and insert it in a small acrylic frame turned up-side down. Place the frame on its side in front of the displayed item.



### Hologram:

- Clear, acrylic display stand
- Small box
- Tap light
- Waxed paper
- Fabric
- Colored pencils



**Hologram:** Print the hologram from clipart onto paper that will fit your frame. Lay a piece of waxed paper over the picture. Trace the lines onto the waxed paper. Cut away any waxed paper that does not have lines. Cut out the vase and attach it to the waxed paper and put it in the display stand. Place a piece of fabric over a small box. Place a tap light in the box. Set the frame over the tap light.

**Desert Cave Music:** Use crumpled brown paper to create a cave around the door of the music room. Hang paper from the ceiling to create stalactites. Make stalagmites by covering a cone with brown paper.



**Scroll Jar:** Cut a chip can in half. Cut the center section from another chip can. Tape the center section between the top and bottom of the other can. Tape a small plastic cap in the center of the chip can lid. Cover the lid and the can with pieces of masking tape. Rub a crayon over the tape.

To make a scroll to fit inside the scroll jar: cut some textured paper and glue a dowel to each end. Glue wooden knobs to the end of each dowel to create finials.



**Dig Log:** *Print a sticker saying, "Dig Log" to place on the front of a journal with an elastic band.*



## Pith Helmet

Paper plate

- Paper bowl
- Cord
- Hole punch & reinforcing stickers
- Cord
- Wooden bead
- Tape



*Put the bowl in the center of the plate and trace around it. Cut out the circle a little smaller than the bowl, so that the rim of the bowl will set inside. Use a long-reach hole punch to punch 2 vent holes on each side of the bowl. Color the hole reinforcing stickers brown and place one over each hole. Place narrow tape across the front. Fold the cord and insert it through a wooden bead. Glue the other ends of the cord to the plate to create the chin strap.*

## Column:

- Contact paper
- Cardboard tube
- Boxes
- Permanent markers

*Cover the boxes and the tube with contact paper. Place one box on the top. Cut a circle in the other box and insert the other end of the tube through the hole. Use a permanent marker to add cracks.*
