

FALLS CREEK INDIAN BAPTIST ASSEMBLY

Rules and Regulations

(Note: It is recommended that a copy of these rules and regulations be provided to the parents/guardians and all campers so improper clothing is not brought to IFC.)

Conduct and discipline at the Assembly is the cooperative responsibility of each camp and church. Each cabin shall have ample designated adult sponsors whose names shall be registered with the Assembly management. Cooperation is urged and expected from every elder, pastor, and from each person attending this Assembly; promotion Christian conduct, sanitation, general welfare, and safety for all who attend. **A representative from each cabin should attend the mandatory orientation scheduled Monday afternoon, the first day of camp.**

Falls Creek Baptist Indian Assembly is a Christian camp. Campers are expected to dress with a Christian attitude and should follow the New Testament principles of modesty. The purpose of these rules enforces the concept of good attitudes and behavior among campers. Our purpose should not be to draw attention to ourselves, but to display those qualities of conduct that honor Christ. These rules apply to every camper whether they are Christians or not.

Beginning Monday, the first day of camp, clothing rules are in effect. Shorts are allowed for each service **but remember all clothing is to be no shorter than mid-thigh length**. No spaghetti straps, tank tops, (including self-cut tee-shirt sleeves), halter tops, midriffs or tight clothing. Proper foundation garments must be worn. Apparel displaying pictures which promote tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, controlled substances OR inappropriate behavior are not allowed.

NOTE: The new enclosed tabernacle is air conditioned and has been reported to be kept very cool.

Unnecessary traffic is prohibited. Careless driving will not be tolerated. Riding on exterior of vehicles besides trucks is prohibited. All traffic and parking regulations are to be observed and will be enforced. Motorcycles and bicycles are not permitted without the permission of the Camp Manager.

Golf carts are available for rent at the expense of the camper for the disabled and handicapped and are allowed only after prior approval.

Alcoholic beverages, smoking rock throwing, water fights, fireworks, tents, recreational vehicles and vandalism are not allowed. Persons not obeying these rules may be subject to dismissal or prosecution.

Everyone is expected to attend classes and worship services.
