Intro - Boldness is our willingness to venture out and do the right thing at the right time, regardless of the barriers or fears we may encounter. Bodacious = being bold in an excellent way.

"The wicked flee when no one is pursuing them, but the righteous are as bold as a lion." (Proverbs 28:1)

I – The apostles knew this boldness.

Romans 15:14-16 / Acts 9:26-28 / Acts 5:12-42

II – We can operate in this boldness to find hope.

"For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control." (2 Timothy 1:7)

"So let us keep on coming boldly to the throne of grace, so that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need." (Hebrews 4:16)

"I've commanded you, haven't I? Be strong and courageous. Don't be fearful or discouraged, because the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." (Joshua 1:9)
