Renovate SEMO

"For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ." - 1 Corinthians 12:12

God has created His people to be diverse, in part, by uniquely gifting and positioning us to build up his church and reach the world for Christ. Not only is this true for individual Christians but it's also true for local churches. Every local church has been uniquely gifted by the Holy Spirit for specific ministries, and each has been positioned in unique communities and cultures to engage their neighbors with the Gospel. God intends for every one of our churches to play a special role in His mission to make disciples of all nations.

Renovate SEMO exists to help churches realign themselves with God's specific vision for their church so that every church within our association can make the impact that God intends for His glory. Right now, we have four churches in the Renovate process. Each church has a very unique community, from the very rural to a small village to a larger town, and each church has a unique gifting from God. Our churches are in the process of doing community surveys to better understand those communities and identify how their gifts intersect with needs in the community. I can't wait to see how God revitalizes these churches for His glory and reaches many throughout these communities for Christ.

Additionally, we are launching the Renovate SEMO Residency in partnership with the North American Mission Board this August. We have two tracks for training pastors to lead revitalization. First, we have the Credit Track that enables students to receive masters level credit for their work at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. It is an intensive track that immerses students in strong and struggling churches for revitalization experience. Second, we have the Certificate Track that enables students to receive training through monthly cohort meetings and assignments that fits into an already busy schedule of a full-time, bi-vocational, or volunteer minister.
