He has started 2 churches and is beginning a work that will hopefully lead to a 3rd church.

I am excited to announce that the CPC has just called Bro. Enoc Baeza to be our second church planting catalyst for southeast Mo. Bro. Enoc will be working among the Hispanic population. FBC Fredericktown has offered to allow him to live in a house they own next to their church and they have offered to be the sponsoring church. Bro. Enoc and his wife should arrive sometime in early March to begin this new ministry.

We are so excited to see what God is doing and going to do. The ability to bring a second catalyst has been a prayer of the CPC for the past 3-4 years. God has provided the resources necessary to start this ministry and has now brought a catalyst to begin the work of planting multiple churches among the Hispanic population of southeast Mo.

Know that your faithful support of the association and the CPC is what makes this possible. Please be in prayer for Bro. Enoc and his wife as they prepare to move and begin a new ministry. Also, be in prayer regarding how you church might become involved in this ministry.


Please continue to pray for our new students and their growth in Jesus. Also, please pray for our lost students as they continue to hear the gospel!
