

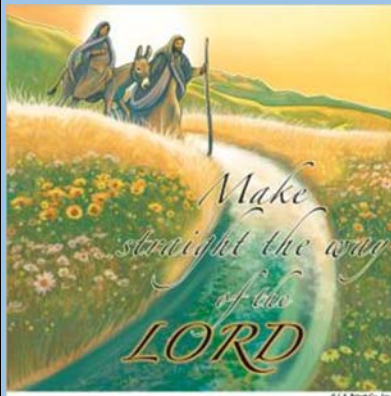

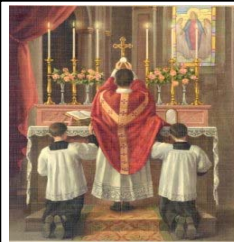
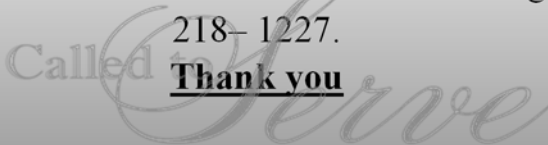


Altar Server and Extraordinary Minister Training

On January 6th and 12th, there will be training for anyone interested in becoming an altar server or a Extraordinary minister.

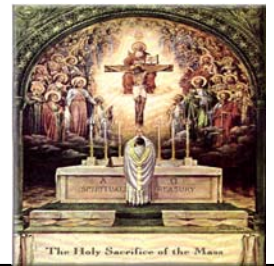

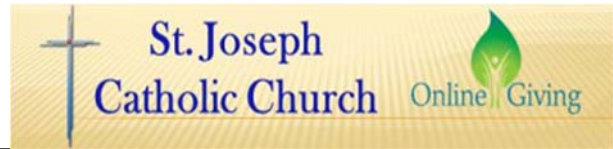

New Safe Environment Training Effective July 1, 2017

As of July 1st, a new training for Safe Environment supersedes all prior Safe Environment clearances and a new training must be completed. Volunteers who resume volunteering later, must complete the new training prior to starting any volunteering work around children and other susceptible persons.

This new training is put out by Catholic Mutual Group, our insurance company. You can acquire access to the new test at the same web address used previously, www.CMGConnect.org. Please use the same password that you used before. If you do not remember your old password, do not create another one. This will complicate the process for you. Instead, contact me, your parish Safe Environment Coordinator. I will be able to contact the diocese and retrieve your password for you. When you are ready choose the new training named "Safe Haven".

If you are thinking of volunteering to work with children and you have never created a profile, this would be a good time to begin and the first step would be to go to the same web address www.CMGConnect.org. Choose Santa Rosa as your diocese and take the test "Safe Haven", just follow the steps to complete this 90-minute test.

Saint Joseph's parish welcomes new and the returning volunteers. As Safe Environment Coordinator, I am here to help assist you in keeping our parish safe for our children.

REJOICE

Isaiah proclaims truly good news to us! God's coming brings not sadness, guilt, fear, wrath, or condemnation. No, God's coming is a source of comfort and joy. Saying it once is not enough, for today's readings are full of joy. Mary's Magnificat substitutes for our psalm today, and our second reading encourages us to rejoice, to give thanks and praise. This is the root meaning of the Greek word for eucharist. We are urged to rejoice and give thanks, because the coming of the Lord brings joy, healing, liberty, release, vindication. It makes the very earth spring up with new life! Good tidings!
