Created by the Archdiocese of Omaha and used by 17 diocese throughout the United States, it is an effective program to educate children and young people to participate in a safe environment, with a strong emphasis on the presence of God in their midst.

## **Program goals**

The goal of the Circle of Grace program is to educate and empower children and young people to actively participate in a safe environment for themselves and others.

## **Program objectives**

Children/young people will understand they are created by God and live in the love of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

God is "present" in everyone's Circle of Grace.

Children/young people will be able to describe the Circle of Grace that God gives each of us.

• God is "present" because He desires a relationship with us.

Children/young people will be able to identify and maintain appropriate physical, emotional, spiritual and sexual boundaries.

• God helps us know what belongs in our Circle of Grace.

Children/young people will be able to identify all types of boundary violations.

God helps us know what does not belong in our Circle of Grace

Children/young people will demonstrate how to take action if any boundary is threatened or violated.

God helps us know when to ask for help from someone who we trust.
