PRIEST

The "Church Fee" is your contribution to the spiritual works of the parish. It does not go to the priest. If you wish to give him a gift for helping you, please put it in an envelope with his name on it and give it to him at the rehearsal.

MUSICIANS

They set their own fees. Pay them before the rehearsal.

PARISH HALL

Hall rental is not included in the above fee. If you are interested, ask the parish secretary for information.

EXPLANATIONS

1) A non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 is required to secure the date and is to be paid *within seven days* after you meet with the priest, who will tentatively set the date with you. If not paid within seven days, the name will be removed from the church calendar and the date will be available for someone else.

2) For Non-Parishioners, a refundable cleaning deposit of \$100.00 is required and is to be paid *within seven days* after you meet with the priest. If the church is left clean and all flowers and decorations have been removed, then your cleaning deposit will be refunded. You can expect your refund within 30 days after your ceremony.

3) The "**Active Parishioner Fee**" is a discount offered to people who have contributed to the life and ministries of the parish. "Active Parishioners" are those who have formally registered in the parish, have used the envelope system in support of the parish for at least one year, and participated in the life of the parish during that period. Included in the category of "Active Parishioners" are children and grandchildren who live elsewhere but whose families are active in the parish.
